**Program Fee**

- One year digital subscription to the NY Times
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

**Host Family**

- Students placed with host family receive 14 meals weekly
- Host family provides linens, does laundry & cleans room weekly

**Residence Housing**

- Double room with a private bath & kitchenette; fully catered (3 meals per day during the program period)
- Includes utilities; weekly cleaning service; linens & towels; onsite, coin-operated washers & dryers; access to onsite gym; access to photocopying & printing services for a fee; 24-hour onsite staff

Charges for tuition, program fee and course fees are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
