### Program Fee

- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Accommodation is in the dormitories at University of Freiburg and is invoiced by Colgate, along with the residency permit and mandatory government health insurance fee
- Roundtrip airfare JFK-Frankfurt (see below for more information)
- Field trips with some meals included
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One year digital subscription to the NY Times
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

### Meals

- Estimate includes most meals during the program period

### Airfare

- Airfare can be purchased by the student instead of being billed through Colgate. This will lower the program fee by an estimated \$1500

Charges for tuition and program fee are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
