### Program Fee

- Housing with a host family with some meals provided or students in DIS-arranged housing will receive a stipend for food
- DIS arrival workshop, various cultural and social events
- Program integrated study tours and course integrated field studies
- Health, accident, and personal liability insurance
- Residence Permit
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service

- Pre-departure materials and advising

### Course Fees
