Australian Universities

Information for students who are considering attending an Australian University. Here is some key information that you need to know before going abroad. Please note that the Australian Universities academic calendar is much different from the US academic calendar. You must complete the full academic semester. No Exceptions. Semester 1 - Late February - End of June, Semester 2 - Late July - Middle of November with the exception of the University of New South Wales Semester 1 which will start in January and go until May.

- You will be charged on your Bursar account SU tuition and a program fee to SU <u>only</u>. (You do not have to pay the Australian tuition, only Syracuse University tuition) SU does not pay for accommodations or fees. Please see the Australian budget attached to our brochure page on the Syracuse Abroad website.
- You will pay any housing costs, meal plans, and/or other fees directly to the Australian University. (NOTE: UNSW and the University of Sydney students live on-campus, <u>no exceptions</u>).

Up Front Costs and Financial Aid

Students must pay the below costs upfront. We cannot charge your Bursar account for these costs. A credit card must be used to pay for the Australian insurance and visa. You apply for your visa on-line and pay for your Australian insurance during the acceptance process.

- Australian insurance OSHC \$250-\$300 (approximately)
- Visa \$550 (must be paid on line during the visa application process with a major credit card)
- Housing application fee approximately \$73
- Housing deposit approximately \$160-\$700 depending on the university
- You will retain all financial aid when you apply to a World Partner program. If you have funds left on your Bursar account after the tuition and the program fee are paid to SU then you MUST request a refund from your MySlice account. Syracuse Abroad does not pay Australian Universities for housing, meals or any fees.

Unique to each campus

University of Queensland

Housing - UQ students will live off campus. Students are guaranteed accommodations. Housing accommodations have been vetted and approved through UQ. Please visit their housing <u>website</u> for more information. You will pay the accommodations directly.

University of New South Wales

All UNSW student will live on campus Student apply for housing through a link after acceptance. Housing application fee - \$73 (approximately) Housing deposit - approximately \$760-\$800.

University of Sydney

Students will live on campus and guaranteed accommodations Accommodations at Queen Mary Building (QMB) AUD\$200 acceptance fee and AUD\$50 cleaning fee
