### Program Fee

- Room (Homestay or shared apartment)
- Meals (if with a host family)
- All-inclusive one-week orientation
- Three program-organized excursions
- Medical insurance, including medical evacuation/repatriation, and political & security evacuation coverage
- Program supplied mobile phone for use while in Jordan (usage charges not included)
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One year digital subscription to the NY Times
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

### Meals

- Includes meals not covered by the program fee

Housing deposit \$300 (only for students living in apartments--refundable at conclusion of semester if apartment is clean and there has been no damage other than normal wear and tear). Meals expense will be higher by an estimated \$2200.

Charges for tuition and program fee are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
