Program Fee

- The homestay fee includes 16 meals weekly (two meals [breakfast and dinner] on weekdays, and three meals on weekends)
- Dormitory rooms are single occupancy and assumes students will prepare most meals in the dormitory kitchen facility
- Syracuse Abroad Insurance includes emergency travel insurance
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One year digital subscription to the NY Times
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortifies the broad support we have in place for our students
- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

Meals

- Estimate includes lunch (or third meal), five days a week during the program period for homestay students; dormitory meals estimate includes 21 meals weekly

Charges for tuition and program fee are fixed and billed through the Syracuse University bursar system. Other expenses are estimated based on current information and are subject to change due to inflation and fluctuating exchange rates.
