*Program fee includes:

- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One-year digital subscription to the New York Times
- Pre-departure materials and advising
- Fortification of the broad support in place for Syracuse Abroad students
- Services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

**Personal expenses and travel

Includes hotel and travel during the 10-day break period, as well as communications expenses, laundry, weekend travel, and other sundries during the program period.

Other Billable Costs:

Mandatory Course Fees: \$60-\$365; invoiced after course registration

Study at Foreign Universities: Program fee varies subject to student's registration and housing requirements.
