### Program Fee

- Pre-departure materials and advising; onsite orientation

- Housing in local apartments
- Students choosing Residencia or Homestay housing options will incur an additional fee
- International Student ID Card (includes secondary, excess emergency insurance and student discounts)
- Membership with International SOS Assistance, a medical and security advisory service
- One year digital subscription to the NY Times

- Includes services not covered by tuition and for which a separate fee is not charged

### Meals

- Includes three meals a day, seven days a week during the program period. Assumes students will prepare most of their meals in their flats.
